Purpose of award

This scholarship is intended to assist in defraying expenses to the NOSS conference.

Definition of an adjunct instructor

An instructor who is employed on a part-time basis with a higher education program that supports student success

Criteria for evaluation

- One year as a NOSS member
- At least two years of experience and current employment as an adjunct educator in a higher education program that supports student success
- Two letters of support from supervisors or colleagues
- Up to one page explaining how the applicant would share information obtained from NOSS with colleagues

Special features

- Fee waiver for the NOSS basic conference registration

Directions for application

- Verification of NOSS membership
- Name of employing institution
- Title of teaching position(s)
- Two letters of support from supervisors or colleagues
- One to two paragraphs explaining how the applicant would share information obtained from NOSS with colleagues
