Purpose of award

This award honors recently completed non-thesis/dissertation research by a NOSS member in published or unpublished form.

Criteria for evaluation

- NOSS membership
- Significance to the field of student success
- Theoretical/research basis
- Rationale for the study
- Description of research methodology
- Soundness of conclusions from research
- Quality of the article
- Publication of research or documentation that publication is forthcoming

Special features

- \$500 stipend (to be shared if more than one person is involved in the project)
- Invitation to present at following year's NOSS conference
- Plaque for up to three individuals involved in the research project

Directions for application

- Provide a copy of the research article.
- Provide an explanation of the rationale for the study and the significance to the field of up to one page.
- See the Awards page on the NOSS website for specific requirements for submission of application packet to the Awards Committee chair.

Award honoree

This award is named in honor of Hunter Boylan to recognize his outstanding leadership in the fields of developmental education and educational research. Dr. Boylan is a Past President of NOSS and the past Director for the National Center for Developmental Education at Appalachian State University.
